Did you know?

- ◆ Breastfeeding protects infants from ear infections.
- ◆ Breastfeeding protects infants from diarrhea.
- ◆ Breastfeeding is good for mothers!
- ◆ The American Academy of Pediatrics recommends breastfeeding for *at least* the first year of life.
- ◆ Artificial baby milk (formula) is NOT the same as human milk, and *may increase certain health risks* to your baby.
- ◆ Human milk is simply the best nutrition for human babies!!
